


Fruit Seed Matching Answer Key

Did you know?

*Some fruits, like peaches and avocados, have pits. A pit protects the seeds inside until it can start to grow. Fruits that contain pits only have one, while fruits that contain seeds have many! Think of a kiwi versus an avocado.

*Try it! You can sprout fruit seeds for fun at home, though it will not grow to the size needed to fruit as many of the seeds will not survive in our climate and take years to grow. All you need is a small container of soil to plant your leftover fruit seed. Wait a few days and see what happens!
