Glue

Scissors

What to do:

- 1. Print out the sheep template below.
- 2. Color the face and the legs of the sheep. Be creative!
- 3. Cut out the sheep using a scissors and the help of a grown-up if needed.
- 4. Now it's time to add the wool! You can arrange the "wool" on your sheep by pulling apart cotton balls and filling in the body.
- 5. Glue the cotton down. You only need to use a small amount of glue.
- 6. Let the glue dry. You are all done!
