Make a Giraffe Headband!

What you need:

Giraffe crown template (see link on website)

Yellow paper or coloring utensils (markers, crayons, etc.)

Orange paper or coloring utensils


Stapler

Scissors

Tape or Glue

What to do:

- Print out the giraffe headband template on yellow paper. You can
 download a PDF on our website where you found these instructions. If you do not have yellow
 paper, you can print off on white paper and color in the template.
- 2. Cut out the pieces. When cutting out the headband piece, make sure you cut out two strips of paper so it's large enough.
- 3. Create your head band. Staple the headband piece together so it fits your child's head snugly.
- 4. Cut out your two ears, and two ossicones (those are the horn-like structures on a giraffe's head).
- 5. Glue or tape your ears and ossicones to the headband.
- 6. Cut out and tape or glue orange spots for your giraffe headband. If you don't have orange paper, you can color orange spots with coloring utensils.
- 7. You're all done!
