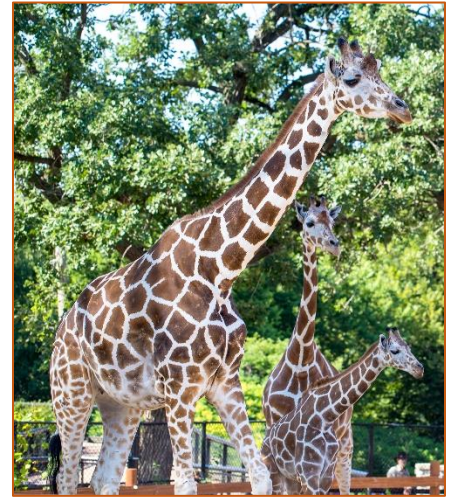


Make a Giraffe Headband!

Kick-off our celebration of World Giraffe Day with us by making a giraffe headband with your kids!

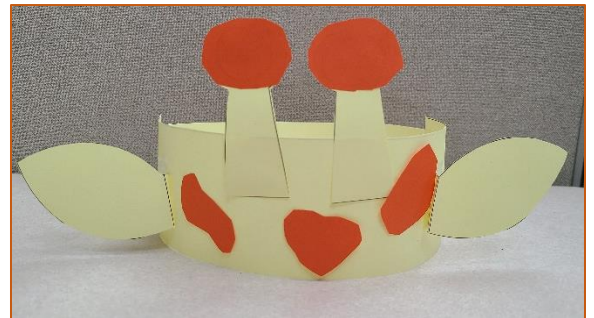
What you need:

- Giraffe crown template (see link on website)
- Yellow paper or coloring utensils (markers, crayons, etc.)
- Orange paper or coloring utensils
- Stapler
- Scissors
- Tape or Glue



What to do:

1. Print out the giraffe headband template on yellow paper. You can download a PDF on our website where you found these instructions. If you do not have yellow paper, you can print off on white paper and color in the template.
2. Cut out the pieces. When cutting out the headband piece, make sure you cut out two strips of paper so it's large enough.
3. Create your head band. Staple the headband piece together so it fits your child's head snugly.
4. Cut out your two ears, and two ossicones (those are the horn-like structures on a giraffe's head).
5. Glue or tape your ears and ossicones to the headband.
6. Cut out and tape or glue orange spots for your giraffe headband. If you don't have orange paper, you can color orange spots with coloring utensils.
7. You're all done!
