Egg Painting

This activity is a new spin on a painting project and gives you a colorful house decoration!

What you need:

Eggs

Large sewing needle

Bowl

Acrylic paint & paint brushes

Plate

Wire rack or dishrack

Egg carton or cup



What to do:

- 1. First, wash your egg well and let it drip dry on a dishrack.
- 2. Using a large needle, push it into one end of the egg and make a hole. Push the needle into the yolk to break it.
- 3. Make a small hole on the opposite end of the egg.
- 4. Blow into that small hole, holding the egg over the bowl. The yolk should come out the larger hole.
- 5. Carefully wash the empty egg. Let it drip dry on a dishrack.
- 6. Now you are ready to decorate! Place your egg in an egg carton or cup to keep it standing upright.
- 7. You can first lightly pencil a design on an egg. Maybe draw your favorite zoo animal!
- 8. Using acrylic paint, paint your designs on the egg. Be sure to let it dry before painting the bottom.
- 9. You are all done!
