Handprint Penguins Craft

What you need:

Black construction paper

White felt (construction paper works too)

Orange construction paper

Two googly eyes

Glue stick

Pencil

Scissors



What to do:

- 1. Have your child trace their hand on a black piece of paper. Make sure their fingers are spread slightly apart.
- 2. Help your child cut their handprint out of the paper. Flip the handprint upside-down so the fingers are pointing downward.
- 3. Cut an oval piece of white felt or construction paper. Make sure this piece covers most of the middle of the handprint, with only the fingertips showing.
- 4. Fold a small rectangular piece of orange paper in half. Cut out a "V" pattern along the edge of the paper with the opening of the "V" on the fold.
- 5. Now put your penguin together! Glue on the white front side. Arrange the googly eyes and orange beak to create your penguins face. Glue them in place.
- 6. You are all done!
