Paper Chain Snake

Help your kids make their own paper chain snake by following the easy instructions below!

What you need:

Two types of colored paper or construction paper

Small piece of red construction paper

Ruler

Scissors


Tape or glue stick

Googly eyes (optional)



What to do:

- Cut 5 strips of one color and four strips of the other color.
 Make sure your strips are about 10 inches long and about 2 inches wide. Measure using a ruler.
- 2. Start by making your snake's head and make one paper ring. Tape or glue the ring together.
- 3. Start your paper snake body pattern. Begin by using the same color as the head, and then alternate colors.
- 4. Tape or glue the strips around each other one by one and form the into a ring.
- 5. Repeat the process and make your paper chain snake until you have used all your construction paper strips.
- 6. Once you have made your snake body, glue on two googly eyes on the head segment. Alternative you can draw eyes.
- 7. Finally, using a small strip of red paper, make a tongue for your snake. You can cut a long, skinny strip into a fork on the end. Glue or tape this on under the eyes.
