

Paper Flowers

Spring is here! Make some paper flowers for fun and easy decorative craft.

What you need:

Variety of construction paper

Scissors

Glue stick

Ruler



What to do:

1. Cut your construction paper into $\frac{1}{2}$ inch strips. Cut the paper across horizontally. You will need 3-4 strips of paper per flower.
2. Lay two strips of paper evenly perpendicular so that they cross at the middle.
3. Place a dot of glue in the middle where the paper crosses.
4. Fold one of the ends of paper in and stick it to the glue. This will create a loop.
5. Repeat the process by putting a glue dot between each paper end. You should then have four loops.
6. You can add 1-2 more strips of paper diagonally. Repeat the gluing process and folding in of edges.
7. Once you have a flower with "petals", you can cut a small yellow circle and glue it to the center.
8. Repeat the process to create flowers of various colors!
