

Handprint Flowers

This is a fun and easy craft to do with your kids for some colorful springtime décor!

What you need:

- Colored construction paper
- Pencil
- Scissors
- Glue



What to do:

1. Have your child trace their hand, or help them trace their hand, on colored construction paper.
2. After they trace their hand, help them cut it out.
3. Cut a small ½ inch strip of green construction paper. This is your flower stem.
4. Cut leaves for your flower out of green construction paper. Your leaves can be whatever leaf shape you'd like!
5. Construct your flower. Glue the handprint on the top of your stem, and the leaves on the sides.
6. You can make a variety of different color handprints! Display them where you'd like!
