Handprint Flowers

This is a fun and easy craft to do with your kids for some colorful springtime décor!

What you need:

Colored construction paper

Pencil

Scissors

Glue



What to do:

- 1. Have your child trace their hand, or help them trace their hand, on colored construction paper.
- 2. After they trace their hand, help them cut it out.
- 3. Cut a small ½ inch strip of green construction paper. This is your flower stem.
- 4. Cut leaves for your flower out of green construction paper. Your leaves can be whatever leaf shape you'd like!
- 5. Construct your flower. Glue the handprint on the top of your stem, and the leaves on the sides.
- 6. You can make a variety of different color handprints! Display them where you'd like!
