

Pine cone Bonsai

Bonsai means “container planting”. Believe it or not, you can start growing your own bonsai with a pinecone that you find in your backyard!

What you need:

- Young, fresh pinecone
- Potting soil
- Growing container



What to do:

1. Find an ideal pinecone for your bonsai. You will need to find a pinecone that is young and fresh and isn't open yet. A larger pinecone works better as that has the best seeds.
2. Prepare a container with potting soil. A small container similar to the size of your pinecone will do.
3. Loosely plant your pinecone in the soil. Don't bury the pinecone, leave the top exposed so the seeds can grow.
4. That's it! Water your pinecone sparingly and watch it sprout over the next few days!
