Zookeeper Apprenticeship

Thank you for your interest in the **Zookeeper Apprenticeship** position through Right Track's Pathways to Employment at Como Park Zoo and Conservatory. This Apprenticeship is a year-long commitment with the option to extend to a second year, preference is given to City of St Paul residents.

Apprentice must:

- Be a City of St Paul resident
- Come from a cost burdened household and/or have a barrier to employment
- Be enrolled in a college or university pursuing a degree in a related field
- 18- 24 years old

A completed application includes:

- Cover letter indicating reasons for interest in an Apprenticeship at Como
- Resume summarizing educational and employment experiences
- Two letters of recommendation, one being from a college instructor or similar collegiate mentor who can speak to your academic performance and commitment to your major
- Completed application form

Applications are open until position filled, with priority to applicants submitted on or before May 1st, 2022

Zookeeper Apprentice

This apprenticeship at Como Zoo is designed to provide necessary experience to obtain a job as a Zookeeper post-graduation. Apprentices gain career learning in animal husbandry, data collection, and food preparation as well as ongoing professional skills trainings. This is a paid opportunity through Right Track and the City of St Paul, Apprentices will receive \$15.00/hour.

Duties

- Assist with daily diet preparation, daily feeding, and husbandry
- Provide enrichment for the animals
- Assist with routine record keeping and participate in weekly veterinary consultation
- Provide routine animal observation, reporting any concerns to the keepers on duty
- Perform other duties as assigned

Responsibilities

- Demonstrate safe, professional, and respectful behavior in all work areas
- Follow established policies and procedures when working on Como Campus
- Address issues and concerns in a timely and professional manner
- Work pre-arranged shift, up to 40 hours/week in the Summer and up to 20 hours/week during the School Year
- Give advanced notice for shift changes
- Fulfill all training requirements and provide feedback

Qualifications

- Currently be in a degree program in zoology, biology or a related field with preference given to those interested in a career in zoo keeping/animal care
- Come from a cost burdened household and/or have a barrier to employment. Preference given to City of St Paul residents.
- Ability to commit to Apprenticeship for a minimum of one year, option to extend to a second year
- Be available to work weekdays, weekends, and holidays
- Demonstrate high quality ability to work independently or with a team
- Ability to move objects in excess of 50 lbs. daily
